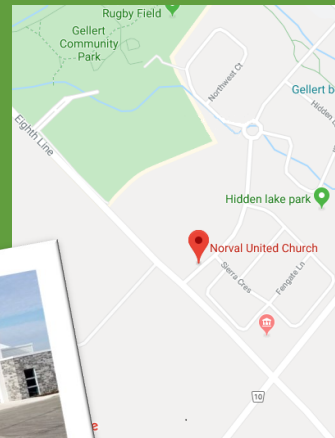

Who can participate?

We take campers going into SK up to Grade 6. Older youth may join our leadership programs as Jr. Volunteers (Grade 7 & 8) or Volunteer Counsellors (Gr 9+). We accept registrations on a first come first serve basis for up to 2 weeks each season.



How do I register?

How can I pay the camp fee?

Do you have Before/After Care?

Yes! Available from 8 – 9 a.m., and 3:30-5 p.m. The cost is \$5/camper for each morning or afternoon required. Please register minimum 48hrs ahead so we can schedule the appropriate number of staff.

What should my child bring to camp?

- * Sun protection: hat and sunscreen for the day. We will spend time outdoors and have limited tree shade.
- * A reusable water bottle.
- * A litterless lunch and snack. We provide an additional afternoon snack.
- * Bathing suit/extra clothes and a towel for water days only.
