



Lead Counsellor 2022 NUC Summer Camp Program

Camp Description:

The NUC Summer Day Camp aims to provide affordable, engaging and faith-filled children's summer programs for families within the community. We do this by keeping our fees low, providing valuable leadership opportunities for middle and high school students, and creating a diverse and inclusive summer camp program.

NUC Summer Camp is based on values of inclusivity and making sure that everyone feels welcome. We seek to create a safe space for all people by encouraging gender inclusive language as well as promoting healthy positive interactions among all staff and campers. During our 5 weeks of camp, we emphasize structured and unstructured play, outdoor time, and a variety of activities based on our weekly themes, all using a lens of faith and spirituality.

The position of Lead Counsellor includes:

- Supervising camper sign-in and sign-out, making regular check-ins with parents during the process
- Leading daily "all camp activities" to provide role modelling and/or breaks for HS Volunteer Counsellors and JR Volunteers
- Organizing daily program activities, ensuring HS Volunteer Counsellors have all necessary information, skills and supplies to run their activities
- Supervising and mentoring HS Volunteer Counsellors and JR Volunteers, participating in training, assisting with the running of activities as needed, and ensuring volunteers get appropriate snack and rest breaks
- Delegating tasks among High School Volunteer Counsellors and Junior Volunteers to ensure a smooth running of the program throughout the day
- Problem solving camper concerns to ensure a safe environment for all and taking a leadership role in promoting positive peer cueing
- Recognizing and making accommodations for any campers with special needs or concerns

The preferred candidates will demonstrate:

- A positive, sensitive and inclusive attitude towards working with children
- Experience working with groups of school age children in a recreational setting
- Ability to manage and delegate tasks, and encourage skill development in others
- Ability to communicate effectively with children, parents, and co-workers

Required:

Successful candidates will be required to provide a Vulnerable Sector Criminal Records Check (if they are over 18yrs). If candidate does not yet have Emergency First Aid Training, NUC will finance their certification.

NUC Summer Camp Offers candidates:

- A positive, supportive and inclusive working environment
- Growth and learning opportunities in leadership, program development, and child recreation skills
- An opportunity to make a difference in the lives of children
