Description:

During camp, we emphasize structured and unstructured play, outdoor time, and a variety of activities based on our weekly themes, all using a lens of faith and spirituality.

- Building a relationship with campers in assigned age group
- Greeting campers as they arrive each day and assisting during group time
- Role modelling and supporting camper participation in all camp activities
- Sitting with campers during nutritional breaks
- Helping with set-up of various camp activities
- Tidying site, including putting supplies away, clearing garbage at end of day, vacuuming

- A willingness to learn new skills and take risks that lead to growth
- Ability to share tasks and provide support and encouragement to teammates
